**CW 9 || C.G. Jung's *Aion* a seminar presented by J. Gary Sparks,
Jungian analyst**

How do historical trends influence an individual's development? What is the nature and origin of our era's emotional task? Why are social and spiritual fragmentation legacies of the twentieth and twenty-first centuries? Where do we go from here? These are the questions Jung addresses in *Aion*, one of his last—and most profound—books. The seminar will investigate the main themes of his work and examine dreams illustrating *Aion's* importance to the practice of analysis.
